

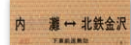

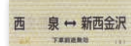
Train Ticket Books

Bicycles on Trains



Allowed all day out of peak hours

Permitted periods

16 Mar. to 30 Nov.

*Not permitted when raining (you may not be allowed to bring your bike if the train floor is slippery due to rain)

Fare for bicycles

Free

(1 bicycle per person only)

Where to carry your bike

Please carry your bike in the second car from the front of the train (you are not permitted to carry bicycles in the first car)



Please note:

- Please do not take your bicycle into the waiting room prior to ticket inspection commencing at Nomachi and Tsurugi stations.
- Customers must hold onto bicycles while on the train so they don't fall over.
- Please be sure that your bicycle is not in the way of other passengers.

Ishikawa Line



Nomachi Station

This line serves passengers travelling from the Nomachi and Nishi-Kanazawa areas towards the Kanazawa Institute of Technology and Tsurugi. It is also convenient for those heading to the Shirayama Hime Shrine.



Asanogawa Line

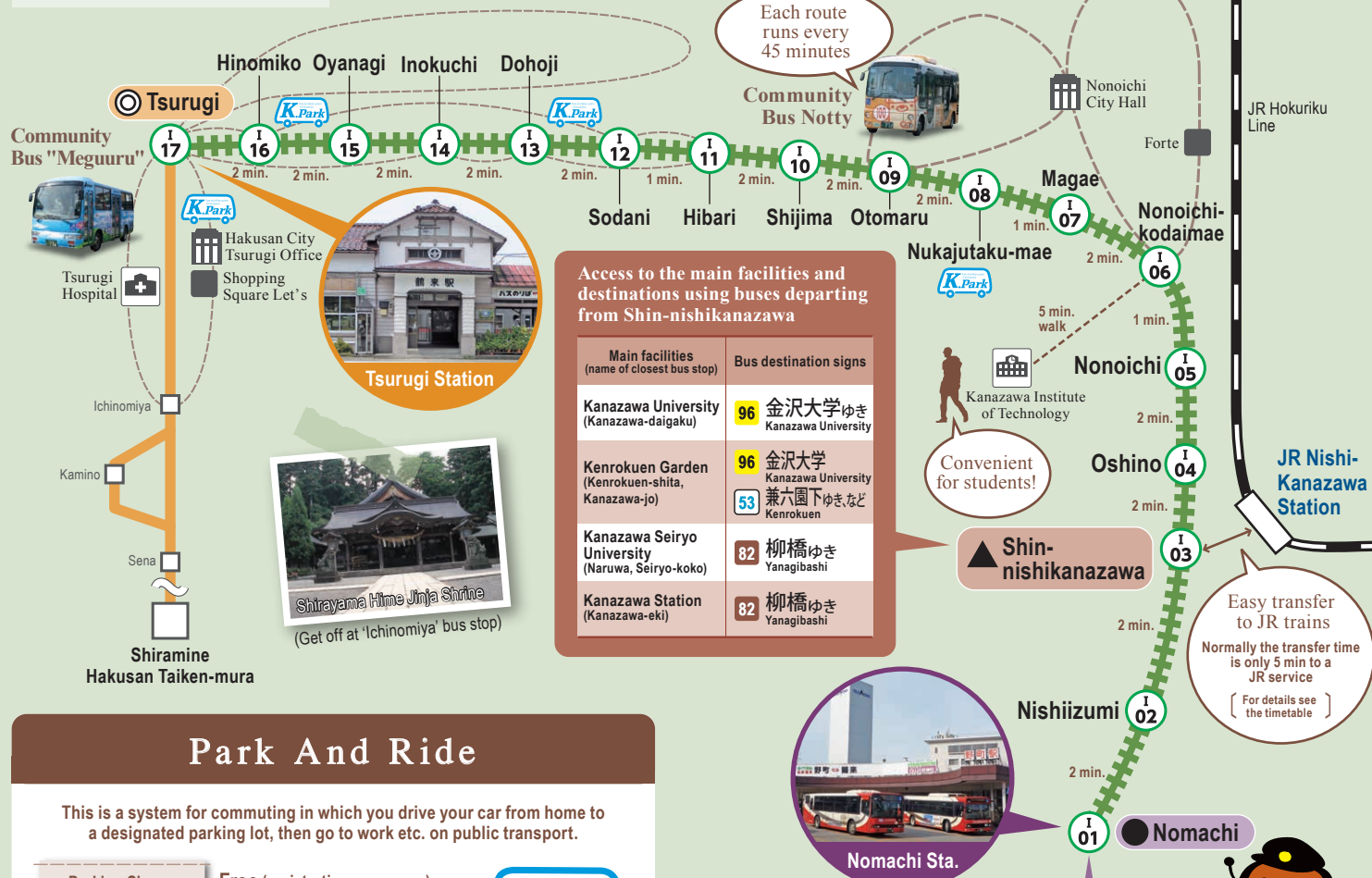


Hokutetsu Kanazawa Station

This line runs towards Uchinada, and its starting point is Hokutetsu Kanazawa Station which is located on the underground floor of the Kanazawa Station. At Uchinada Station there is a bus connection for passengers going in the direction of the Kanazawa Medical University Hospital.

Ishikawa Line

Once you arrive at Nomachi Station, there are good bus connections available for all bus routes.

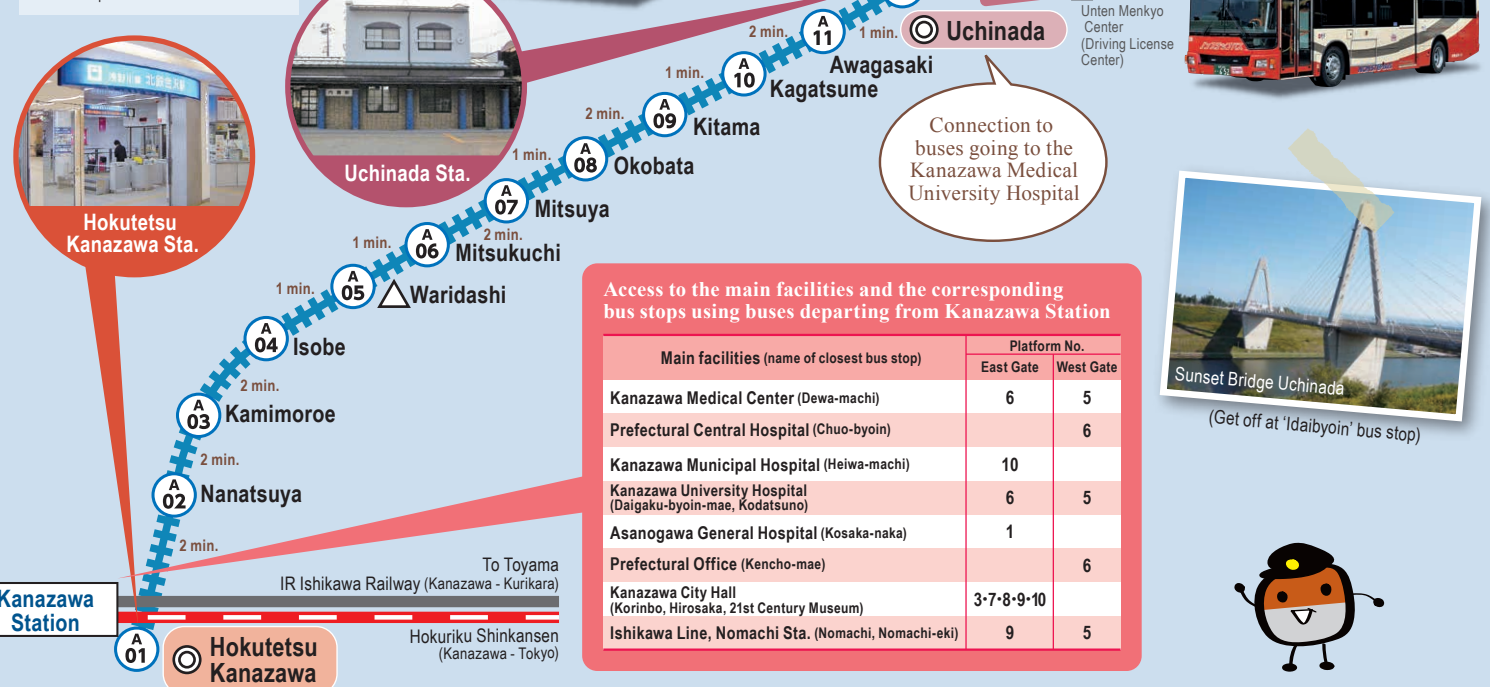
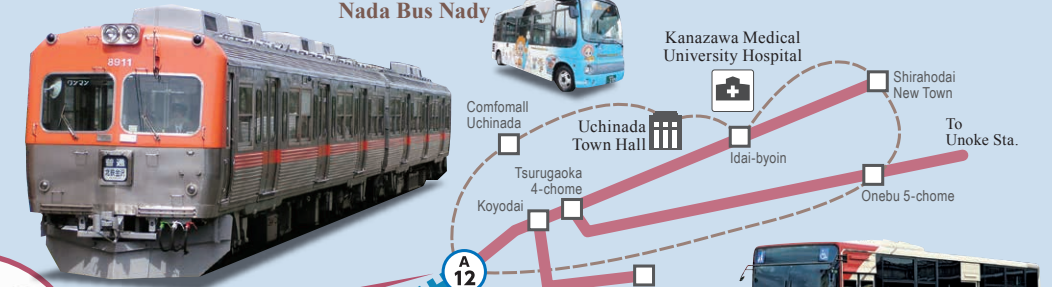

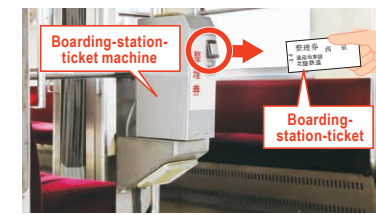


Hokuriku Railroad How to ride 'One-man' trains

All trains on all Hokuriku Railroad lines are operated by one driver only.

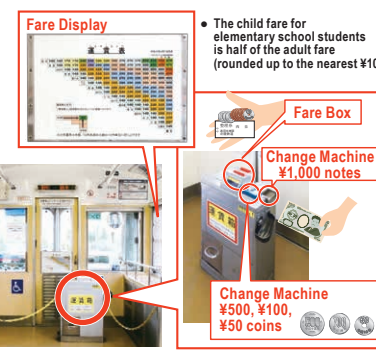
Boarding at an unmanned station

- Enter through the front or rear door of the front car. (Doors in the second car will not open)
- Take a boarding-station-ticket ('seiri-ken') from the machine when boarding.
Pay your fare when you get off. This boarding-station-ticket shows the station where you boarded the train and is required when you get off. Passengers using commuter or one day passes must also take a boarding-station-ticket.



Getting off at an unmanned station

- Get off through the front door of the front car.
- Check your fare shown on the fare display.
- Put the boarding-station-ticket and your fare (or ticket) in the fare box.
Since change is not given, please use the change machine to obtain the exact fare for payment. You can change ¥1,000 notes and ¥500, ¥100 and ¥50 coins on the train. ¥10,000, ¥5,000 and ¥2,000 notes cannot be changed. If you are using a commuter or one day pass, please show it to the driver. (Please put the boarding-station-ticket in the fare box.)



Boarding at a manned station

- Purchase a ticket prior to boarding at an automatic ticket machine or at the ticket counter. No boarding-station-ticket is needed.
- Enter the train through any open door.

Getting off at a manned station

- Get off at any open door.
- Please hand both the boarding-station-ticket and your fare (or ticket) to the station staff at the ticket gate. If using the commuter pass or one day pass, please show it to the station staff. (Please hand the boarding-station-ticket to the station staff.)

In the morning rush hours and other times, there may be a conductor who will sell tickets on the train and collect tickets when you get off.
