

Student Pass (1, 2, 3, 4, 6 or 12 month(s) passes)

Silver Pass (1, 2, or 3 month(s))

It is also environmentally friendly, so why not take a trip on the Hokuriku Railroad Ishikawa Line or Asanogawa Line?






