

How to Ride Local-Line Buses

Enter the bus from the rear door.
Pay the fare when you get off.



Be sure to confirm the destination shown on the front and the side of the bus.



1 Take a numbered ticket (called "Seiri-ken") from the machine when getting on the bus. Please note that numbered tickets ("Seiri-ken") are not issued on Kanazawa Loop Buses and Kanazawa Flat Buses. Simply get on those buses without taking a ticket.



Pay the bus fare when getting off. This numbered ticket shows the bus stop where you got on, and is required to pay the fare.
* On Kanazawa Flat Buses, pay the fare when you get on.

2 After your stop is announced and shown on the display at the front of the bus, press the Request Stop button to let the driver know that you will get off at the next stop. The button will light up.



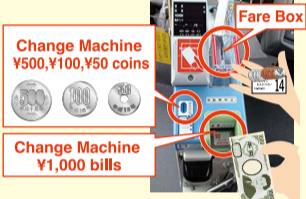
3 Confirm the fare shown on the display.

The child fare (for elementary school students ages 6-12) is half the adult fare (rounded up to the nearest ¥10).



4 When getting off, put both the fare and the numbered ticket in the fare box next to the driver.

Since change is not given, please use the change machine to put the exact fare in the fare box.
¥10,000, ¥5,000, and ¥2,000 bills cannot be changed.



Using the ONE DAY PASS (within usable service area)

When getting off, put the numbered ticket in the fare box and show your PASS to the driver.
* When boarding a Kanazawa Flat Bus, show the date on the pass to the driver.



Nationally accepted public transport smart cards, such as Suica, ICOCA, and PASMO, are accepted on JR Buses and Kanazawa Flat Buses (Zaimoku and Nagamachi routes).
Note: Public transport smart cards cannot be used on other buses.

*Get on using the rear door, and get off in the front.

Kanazawa Flat Bus



When boarding a Kanazawa Flat Bus, show the date on the pass to the driver.

Pass Not Valid on Some Buses

The ONE DAY PASS cannot be used on the Kanazawa Light-up Bus and Machi Bus. If the Pass is used for bus trips that leave the designated area (shown inside the red line on the map on the back), you will have to pay the full fare for the entire trip. (Fare will not be discounted for the portion of the trip within the designated area.)

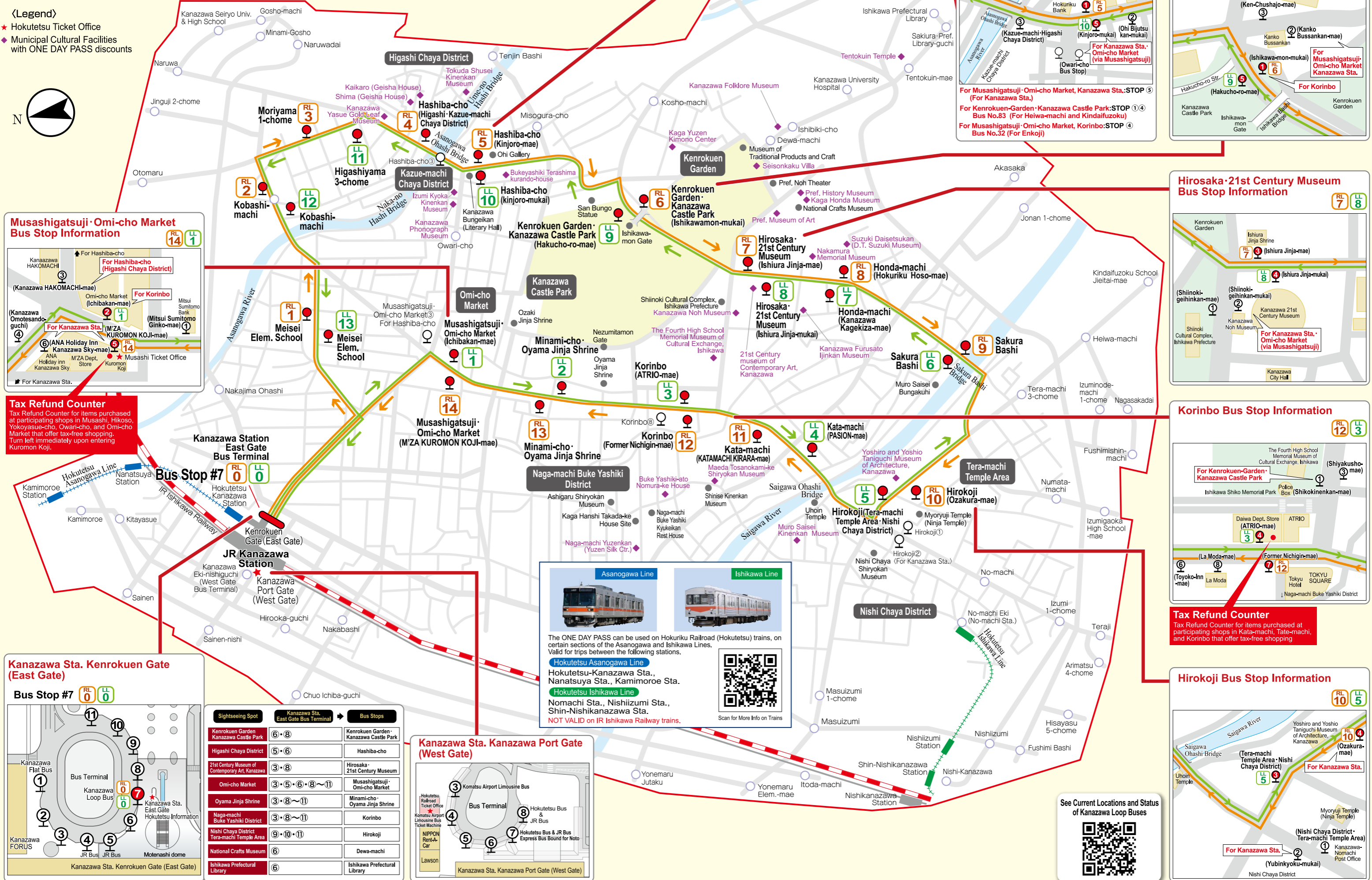
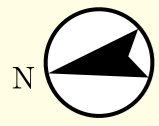
