Inbound: Trains departing from Tsurugi Sta. from 9:38 through 15:19

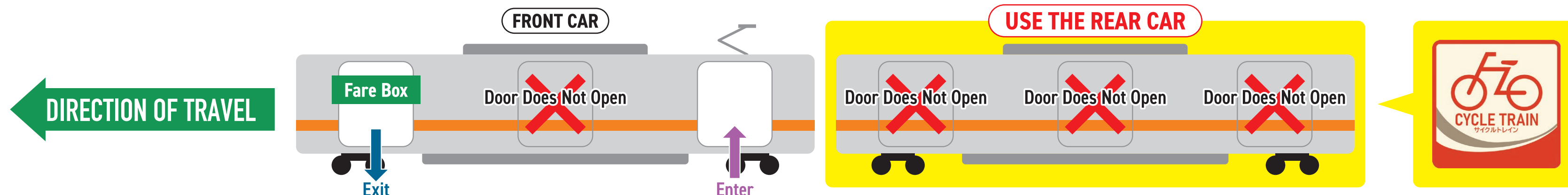

◆ TRAIN CAR TO USE

Bikes are allowed in the REAR CAR ONLY. [No bikes allowed in the front car.]



At unmanned stations along the Ishikawa Line, doors on the rear car do not open.

Getting on at an unmanned station with a bike: **get on through the front car, then go to the rear car.**

Getting off at an unmanned station with a bike: **get off through the front door of the front car.**

[To help prevent train delays, please move from the rear car to the front car when approaching the station, and pay your fare at the fare box.]

At manned stations, the doors on both cars will open.

On the days of major events along the train line, bikes are not allowed on trains, because they will already be very crowded. See our website for dates when Cycle Trains will not be available.

- At Nomachi Sta. and Tsurugi Sta., please do not bring bikes into the waiting room before the ticket gate opens.
- When getting off at a manned station, wait for the doors to open after the train stops.
- Bikes may not be allowed onto crowded trains.
- We assume no responsibility for any problems that may occur at stations or on trains.
- For groups, please contact us beforehand.

© For your safety, please do not move around inside the train, except when getting on or off. Please hold on tightly to your bike to prevent it from falling over.
